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CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 23-020

Comments

2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

a. In s. CSB 2.94 of the proposed rule, the separate statutory actions should be individually designated subsections of s. CSB 2.94. Compare, for example, the subsection numbering used in the existing rule for s. CSB 2.15, for each statutory action. The numbering would appear as follows:

CSB 2.94 Addition of seven (7) synthetic benzimida zole-opioid substances to schedule I. (1) Section 961.14 (2) (mm) and (pe), stats. are renumbered

- (2) Section 961.14 (2) (xm) 1., 2., 4., and 6. to 9., Stats., are created
- b. In s. CSB 2.94 of the proposed rule, the lowercase citation to "stats." should be revised to "Stats.".

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

The plain language analysis of the rule description should mention that, in addition to adding seven synthetic benzimidazole-opioid substances to schedule I, the rule also amends references to two already-scheduled synthetic opiates to include additional scientific description, and renumbers those two to group them with the seven synthetic benzimidazole-opioid substances added to the statute.
