### Analysis of the Rule - Rule Effect - Reason for the Rule

Annually the Department submits rule change proposals relating to fishing regulations. The statewide Spring Fish and Wildlife hearings held in conjunction with the Wisconsin Conservation Congress will be the vehicle identified for citizen input. The proposed changes relate to fishing and clamming. Specifically, these proposals:

- Increase the minimum length limit to 50" for muskellunge in the Lake Winnebago and Fox River system, as part of the Great Lakes spotted musky rehabilitation plan.
- Simplify walleye regulations in Green Bay and Menominee River boundary waters, in conjunction with the Michigan DNR.
- Establish a catch-and-release only fishery for lake sturgeon in the lower Menominee River boundary waters, in conjunction with the Michigan DNR.
- Close harvest of live mussels from inland waters.
- Extend a sunset of experimental walleye and sauger regulations in the Wisconsin River
- Ban "sinker release devices".
- Broaden night bowfishing opportunities.
