Subject

Creation of administrative rules relating to applications, renewal, limited registration and discipline for Professional Employer Organizations (Ch. RL 186).

DESCRIPTION OF POLICY ISSUES.

Objective of the Rule.

The passage of 2007 Wisconsin Act 189 will amend s. 440.08 (2) (a) (intro.) and create s. 440.03 (13) (b) 57m., chapter 461 and 635.02 (7) (b) 3. and 4. of the statutes relating to the registration of Professional Employer Organizations.

Existing Policies Relevant to the Rule, New Policies Proposed and Analysis of Policy Alternatives.

The registration of the Professional Employer Organizations is a new requirement; therefore there are no existing policies relevant to the rules, and no policy alternatives.

Statutory authority.

2007 Wisconsin Act 189 and Wisconsin Statutes 461.

There is no existing or proposed federal regulation that is intended to address the activities to be regulated by the rule.
