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REPORT ON Section Ins 6.79, 8.10, Wis. Adm. Code, relating to advisory councils and committees

Clearinghouse Rule No. 08-064 Submitted Under s. 227.19 (3), Stats.

(a) A detailed statement of basis for the proposed rule and how the rule advances relevant statutory goals or purposes:

The Office of the Commissioner of Insurance("Office" or "Commissioner") is granted authority to create advisory councils and committees by statutes and permits the Commissioner to establish by rule the creation, governance, duties and termination of any council or committee that the commissioner establishes. This proposed rule establishes the structure, governance, duties and termination of councils or committees that the commissioner determines will be of assistance to the Office in carrying out its duty of regulation. The rule repeals s. Ins 8.10 as that council does not operate since the statutes requiring it was repealed. The rule provides the structure to continue existing councils and committees and establishes new committees or councils with a focus and composition reflecting the subjects that are being considered by the agency when needed.
