The purpose of the proposed rules is to repeal limits on emergency assistance grants in the CDBG Program. This will enable the Department to (1) use any available CDBG funds for emergency assistance with repairing or replacing public infrastructure and facilities, and with repairing or replacing homes, after damage by widespread severe storms and flooding; and (2) base the award amounts on the scope of the damages and destruction in the community and on the funds available.

2. How the proposed rule advances relevant statutory goals or purposes.

The proposed rules are consistent with the Department's duty under section 560.04 of the Statutes to assist and strengthen local economic and community development, and the authorization under section 560.9809 to administer housing improvement and rehabilitation grants that are federally funded.
