The 2007 Wisconsin Act 197 affects governmental unit employees who administer and enforce regulations pertaining to design, installation and maintenance of POWTS by limiting the activities that such employees may undertake outside of their governmental employment. The proposed rules implement administrative forfeitures authorized under 2007 Wisconsin Act 197 for violations of these limitations. The department does not anticipate that the rules will substantially increase its workload and the workload can be accommodated within current resources.
