RULE NO.: Chapters Comm 2 and 5

R	ELATING TO: Fees
1.	Types of small businesses that will be affected by the rules.  The most significant proposal establishes a fee for the department's review of continuing educational course submittals relating to credentials administered by the Safety and Buildings Division. The continuing educational courses can be developed and submitted by anyone. The courses are utilized by various trades people credentialed by the department to fulfill educational obligations as a prerequisite to renew their license, certification or registration. Currently, many of the continuing education courses are developed or sponsored by various building trade or inspection associations.
2.	Reporting, bookkeeping and other procedures required for compliance with the rules.  The proposed changes to chapters Comm 2 and 5 do not imposed any additional reporting, bookkeeping or other procedures for compliance.
3.	Types of professional skills necessary for compliance with the rules.  The proposed changes to chapters Comm 2 and 5 do not require any type of professional skills for compliance.
