**NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED RULES TO
THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STAFF**

NOTICE IS GIVEN, pursuant to s. 227.14(4m), Stats., that on this date, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin submitted a proposed rule to the Joint Legislative Council Staff (Rules Clearinghouse) for review. The purpose of the proposed rule, Commission docket 1-AC-240, is to amend Wis. Admin. Code ch. PSC 118 relating to renewable resource credits to conform to the statutory changes made by 2011 Wisconsin Act 155. The degree of impact is expected to be wholly positive, offering greater opportunities to create renewable resource credits.

A public hearing will be held on Friday, June 28, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. at the Public Service Commission building at 610 North Whitney Way, Madison, Wisconsin.
