## GERMANE MODIFICATIONS CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 15-001 DHS 178, relating to campgrounds

**Modification 1:** Section DHS 178.03 (17) "Individual campsite" means a campsite designated for use by 6 or fewer campers, <u>unless the campers are members of an individual family</u>.

**Modification 2:** Section DHS 178.03 (17m) "Individual family" means the principal campsite occupant and persons related to that person as a spouse, child, parent, grandparent, sibling or grandchild, or the spouse's child, parent, grandparent, sibling or grandchild.

**Modification 3:** Section DHS 178.04 (1) (b) An operator-provided camping unit that <u>meets s. DHS</u> <u>178.13 (3) or that has been approved by the department or its agent under sub. (2) <del>and s. DHS 178.13 (3)</del>, may be placed or relocated on any approved campsite.</u>

**Modification 4:** Section DHS 178.11 (5) (a) *Individual campsites*. An operator may designate no more than 20 individual campsites per acre of campground. Each campsite is limited to 6 campers <u>or an individual family</u>.
