CHAPTER PI 34
Technical Changes Needed As A Result of 2013-15 Budget

Analysis by the Department of Public Instruction

Statutory authority: ss. 115.28(7)(h) and 227.11(2)(a)(intro), Stats.

Statute interpreted: s. 115.28(7)(h), Stats.

The basis and purpose of the proposed rule, including how the proposed rule advances relevant statutory goals or purpose:

The proposed rule change makes a change to PI 34 as a result of the 2013-15 budget, 2013 Wisconsin Act 20. 2013 Wisconsin Act 2013 created s. 115.28 (7) (h), Stats., which provides that the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) must promulgate a rule requiring an applicant for a license to provide his or her home address. PI 34 is modified to add a requirement that an applicant for a license must provide his or her home address.

A list of the persons who appeared or registered for or against the proposed rule at a public hearing:

Under s. 227.16(2)(b), Stats., public hearings were not required because rule changes were brought into conformity with changes to 115.28(7)(h).

Summary of public comments relative to the rule, the agency's response to those comments, and changes made as a result of those comments:

No public hearing was held and no comments were received.

Changes to the plain language analysis or the fiscal estimate:

The plain language analysis was changed to include references to ch. PI 34 as a related rule, as well as s. 115.28(7)(h), Stats., as a source of statutory authority and explanation of agency authority in order to complement the existing references.
