

NOTICE OF SUBMITTAL TO LEGISLATURE

Agency: Department of Safety and Professional Services
Clearinghouse Rule: 18-100

On May 31, 2019, the Department of Safety and Professional Services submitted CR 18-100, a proposed rule in final draft form, to the chief clerk of each house of the Legislature. No action was taken by the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules on September 17, 2019. On December 30, 2019, the department withdrew the rule pursuant to s. 227.19 (4) (b) 4., Stats. With this Notice, the department is resubmitting CR 18-100, a proposed rule in final draft form with germane modification, to the chief clerk of each house of the Legislature pursuant to s. 227.19 (4) (b) 4., Stats. The germane modification revises SPS 4.035 (1) (b) and (2) to allow the ability to waive a credential application fee if a family income of the applicant does not exceed 180 percent of the federal poverty line established under 42 USC 9902 (2).

The previously proposed rule set a fee of \$68.00 for all credentials without the ability to waive the fee in the event of financial hardship.
