Board Order No. WM-17-19 Clearinghouse Rule No. 19-131

### Basis and Purpose of the Proposed Rule

The proposed rule implements changes related to ruffed grouse management and hunting regulations that have emerged from the ruffed grouse management plan that require a change in adminstrative code. These changes include adjusting the ruffed grouse management zone boundaries and changing season dates.

### Summary of Public Comments

No written comments were received during the open comment period which closed on November 8, 2019.

#### **Modifications Made**

No modifications were made to the rule as a result of public comments since no comments were received.

# Changes to Rule Analysis and Fiscal Estimate
