15. Benefits of Implementing the Rule and Alternative(s) to Implement	nting the Rule

The proposed rule eliminates dance as a kindergarten through grade 12 subject area for licensure under s. PI 34.047 (3) (d). The proposed rule will also offer the ability for physical education teachers under s. PI 34.047 (3) (L) to teach dance and recognize the dance license as an obsolete license area under s. PI 34.111. Without a rule change, the department would be required to implement ch. PI 34 as the rules currently exist.

16. Long-Range Implications of Implementing the Rule

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By eliminating dance as a kindergarten through grade 12 subject area for licensure, the proposed rule will offer the ability for physical education teachers under s. PI 34.047 (3) (L) to teach dance and recognize the dance license as an obsolete license area under s. PI 34.111.

17. Compare With Approaches Being Used by Federal Government

Because educator licensure in the United States is typically governed by each state and local government, federal regulations are generally silent with respect to the issuance of teacher licenses. As a result, the requirements for licensure vary by state.

18. Compare With Approaches Being Used by Neighboring States (Illinois, Iowa, Michigan and Minnesota) Illinois: One university in Illinois offers a dance educator license. The degree leads to licensure to teach grades 9-12. Iowa: Persons wishing to teach dance in Iowa obtain a major in Kinesiology and Health, with a minor in dance.

Michigan: Michigan discontinued their dance endorsement in the 2017-18 school year. Districts can place teachers with a health and physical education license and demonstrated content knowledge as a teacher in a dance course.

Minnesota: Minnesota offers a dance teacher license under MN Rules s. 8710.4310.
