Clearinghouse Rule No. 24-074: BILINGUAL-BICULTURAL SUPPLEMENTAL LICENSES

REPORT TO LEGISLATURE

I. Basis and Purpose of the Proposed Rule

The objective of the proposed rule is to change ch. PI 34 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code to 1) expand the scope of a bilingual-bicultural license to include any underlying teaching license the educator currently holds or may acquire in the future; and 2) to remove the prohibition on acquiring the bilingual-bicultural license as a three-year license with stipulations.

II. Public Hearing Summary

The hearing notice was published in the October 28th, 2024, edition of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. A public hearing was held on November 22, 2024. No persons testified at the hearing or provided written testimony.
