Clearinghouse Rule No. 25-038: Modifying the 1-year, renewable license with stipulations for school psychologists

REPORT TO LEGISLATURE

I. Basis and Purpose of the Proposed Rule

The proposed rule change modifies the eligibility criteria for a Tier I, 1-year renewable school psychologist license by allowing applicants enrolled in an education specialist or doctoral program that does not confer a master's degree to qualify if they have completed the number of credits equivalent to a master's degree and verifies enrollment in a qualifying program.

II. Public Hearing Summary

The hearing notice was published in the May 27, 2025, edition of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. A public hearing was held on June 18, 2025. No persons testified at the hearing or provided written testimony.
