### FINAL ORDER AMENDING RULES

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin adopts an order to amend Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 132.02(3), relating to ch. PSC 132's definition of "public utility" and sewerage systems access to railroad rights-of-way consistent with statutory change embodied in 1999 Wisconsin Act 9 §§ 2311q and 2311s.

## ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

Statutory authority: Wis. Stat. §§ 196.02(1) and (3), 196.04(4), and 227.11(2) Statute interpreted: Wis. Stat. § 196.04(4)

Wis. Stat. § 196.04(4), permits the Commission, under certain circumstances, to order the extension of a public utility, telecommunications provider, sewerage system operator or cable operator's lines on, over or under the right-of-way of any railroad, or require the tracks of any railroad be extended on, over or under the right-of-way of any public utility, telecommunications provider, sewerage system operator or cable operator. The Commission is required to prescribe conditions and compensation that are equitable and reasonable under the circumstances.

Chapter PSC 132 was created to set forth the compensation to be paid and conditions to be met by the above-described entities for the construction or maintenance of facilities within a railroad right-of-way in cases where the entity and the railroad cannot agree.

A Statement of Scope on this rule was approved by the Commission on May 4, 2000, and was published in the Wisconsin Administrative Register on May 31, 2000.

#### **TEXT OF RULE**

SECTION 1. PSC 132.02 (3) is amended to read:

(3) "Public utility" has the meaning given in s. 196.01 (5), Stats., and includes a "telecommunications provider," as defined in s. 196.01 (8p), Stats., and a "cable operator," has the meaning given in s. 66.0419 (2) (b), and a "sewerage system operator" as defined in s. 196.04 (4) (a) 2, Stats.

#### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

These rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the

Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in Wis. Stat. § 227.22(2)(intro.).
