The Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations proposes an order to renumber ILHR 13.10 (2) (a) to (e) and ILHR 13.10 (4) (a) and (b); to amend ILHR 2.43, ILHR 13.002 Note, ILHR 13.01 (4), ILHR 13.10 (2) (c) to (e), ILHR 13.12, ILHR 13.14, ILHR 13.20 (1) and ILHR 13.21; to repeal and recreate ILHR 13.10 (1), ILHR 13.10 (4) (intro.) and ILHR 13.16 (2) Note 1; and to create ILHR 13.01 (5) Note, ILHR 13.10 (2) (a), ILHR 13.10 (3m), ILHR 13.103, ILHR 13.105 and ILHR 13.18, relating to compressed natural gas.

Analysis of Proposed Rules

Statutory Authority: Sections 101.02 (1) and (15) (a), 101.12 (1) and 101.19, Stats.

Statutes Interpreted: Sections 101.02 (1) and (15) (a), 101.12 (1) and 101.19, Stats.

The Division of Safety and Buildings within the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations is responsible for adopting and enforcing administrative rules relative to the protection of life, health, safety and welfare of employes and frequenters in public buildings and places of employment. The requirements of chapter ILHR 13 contain safety and health rules relating to the design, construction, location, installation, operation, use, repair and maintenance of compressed natural gas equipment in public buildings and places of employment.

The proposed rules consist of miscellaneous changes in chapter ILHR 13 in order to update the code relative to nationally recognized standards and to revise the department's plan review and installation requirements. The basis of chapter ILHR 13 is the incorporation by reference of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard NFPA 52 – Standard for Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Vehicular Fuel Systems. The proposed rules include the incorporation by reference of the 1995 edition of NFPA 52.

The proposed rules revise several requirements relating to the information that must be submitted to the department for plan review and approval. An exemption from plan review and approval is added for vehicle fueling appliances used for outdoor fueling and having no storage capacity. Also, a voluntary one-time approval of materials and equipment is being added in order to improve the efficiency of the plan review process. A new installation application form is being added, as well as a rule clarifying the submittal of revised plans. The proposed rules also require a certificate of installation to be completed by the system installer, with a copy of the certificate to be submitted to the local fire department.

The statutes authorize the department to charge and collect fees to cover the costs of providing plan review and inspection services. The proposed rules contain revisions in the fee schedule in order to more accurately reflect the costs associated with the plan review and inspection of compressed natural gas systems and liquefied petroleum gas systems.

SECTION 2. ILHR 13.002 Note is amended to read:

ILHR 13.002 Note: In addition to the requirements of this chapter, all frequenters-and-employers-in-public-buildings-and-places-of-employment-and employes in public sector places of employment are protected by the provisions of chapter Ind-1000-2000 ILHR 32 - Public Employe Safety and Health Code. Employes in private sector places of employment are protected by the regulations of 29 CFR 1910,-OSHA-2206,-Revised-March-11,-1983 of the U.S. Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

SECTION 3. ILHR 13.01 (4) is amended to read:

ILHR 13.01 (4) "Place of employment" means every place, whether indoors or out or underground, and the premises appurtenant thereto, where either temporarily or permanently any industry, trade or business is carried on, or where any process or operation, directly or indirectly related to any industry, trade or business is carried on, and where any person is, directly or indirectly, employed by another for direct or indirect gain or profit, but does not include any place where persons are employed in private domestic service which does not involve the use of mechanical power or in farming.

SECTION 4. ILHR 13.01 (5) Note is created to read:

ILHR 13.01 (5) Note: This definition is taken from s. 101.01 (2) (g), Stats.

SECTION 5. ILHR 13.10 (1) is repealed and recreated to read:

ILHR 13.10 (1) DEPARTMENT APPROVAL. (a) Except as provided in par. (b), department approval shall be obtained before commencing construction on a compressed natural gas facility installation.

(b) Department approval is not required for vehicle fueling appliances used for outdoor fueling and having no storage capacity.

SECTION 6. ILHR 13.10 (2) (a) to (e) are renumbered ILHR 13.10 (2) (b) to (f).

SECTION 7. ILHR 13.10 (2) (a) is created to read:

ILHR 13.10 (2) (a) At least 4 sets of plans, which are clear, legible and permanent copies, and one copy of specifications, fees and a completed application;

SECTION 8. ILHR 13.10 (2) (c) to (e), as renumbered, are amended to read:

ILHR 13.10 (2) (c) A plot plan, drawn to a minimum scale of one inch equals 20 feet, indicating the location of the facility or installation with respect to property lines, lot lines, adjoining streets or alleys and other buildings on the same lot or property. The layout of buildings, containers, loading and unloading docks, type of construction of each building and any stream or body of water within 150 feet of the containers shall also be indicated;

(d) The location, size and capacity of each <u>system and</u> container;

(e) The type of container supports, clearances, type of safety relief valves used and combined capacity of all safety relief valves on each container, vaporizer, <u>dryer</u> and similar component; and

SECTION 9. ILHR 13.10 (3m) is created to read:

ILHR 13.10 (3m) LOCAL REGULATIONS. This chapter shall not limit the power of cities, villages and towns to make or enforce additional or more stringent regulations, provided the regulations do not conflict with this chapter, any other rule of the department, or law.

SECTION 10. ILHR 13.10 (4) (intro.) is repealed and recreated to read:

ILHR 13.10 (4) (a) Applications for approval of a compressed natural gas facility installation shall be made in writing on form SBD-6038.

Note: The application for installation form (SBD-6038) is available from the Safety and Buildings Division, Customer Service Center, P.O. Box 7969, Madison, WI 53707, telephone 608/266-3151.

SECTION 11. ILHR 13.10(4)(a) and (b) are renumbered ILHR 13.10(4)(b) and (c).

SECTION 12. ILHR 13.103 is created to read:

<u>ILHR 13.103</u> CERTIFICATE OF INSTALLATION. Every person, firm, association or corporation installing compressed natural gas equipment shall complete a certificate of installation form. The certificate of installation form shall be completed at the time of installation, kept at the installation site and available for review by an authorized representative of the department. A copy of the installation form shall be submitted to the local fire department within 10 business days of the installation.

SECTION 13. ILHR 13.105 is created to read:

<u>ILHR 13.105 REVISIONS AND MODIFICATIONS</u>. (1) PLAN REVISIONS. (a) The changes specified in par. (b) to previously approved plans shall be submitted for review as a revision. Revised plans submitted for review shall include the state plan number for the original plans.

(b) Plans shall be submitted to the department for review for changes in tank location or capacity, piping arrangement or material, safety setback clearance, point of transfer location, design of indoor fueling operation, and gas detection or monitoring equipment location.

(2) ADDITIONS AND MODIFICATIONS. Additions or modifications to systems after commencement of system operation shall be submitted for review as a new installation.

SECTION 14. ILHR 13.12 is amended to read:

<u>ILHR 13.12 DEPARTMENTAL LIMITATION AND EXPIRATION OF PLAN APPROVAL</u>. Plan approval by the department or its authorized deputy shall expire $\Theta ne-year 2$ <u>years</u> after the date indicated on the approved plans, if construction has not commenced within that-year those 2 years.

Applications for approval shall include sufficient data, tests and other evidence from an independent third party to prove that the material, equipment or device meets the requirements of this chapter. Upon receipt of a fee and application form SBD-8028, the department may issue an approval number for the material, equipment or device. The department shall review and make a determination on an application for approval within 30 business days of receipt of all forms, fees, information and documents required to complete the review.

Pursuant to s. 227.21, Stats., the attorney general and the revisor of statutes have consented to the incorporation by reference of the National Fire Protection Association Standard for Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Vehicular Fuel Systems, NFPA No. 52-1984 1995.

SECTION 19. ILHR 13.21 is amended to read:

ILHR 13.21 DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, LOCATION, INSTALLATION, OPERATION, USE, REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS FACILITIES. All compressed natural gas facilities shall be designed, constructed, located, installed, operated, used, repaired and maintained as specified in the National Fire Protection Association Standard NFPA 52-1984---Standard-for-Compressed-Natural Gas-(CNG)-Vehicular-Fuel-Systems, as incorporated by reference in s. ILHR 13.20.
