#### <u>ORDER</u>

An order of the Psychology Examining Board to repeal Psy 4.02 (4) (c); and to amend Psy 4.02 (6) relating to continuing education.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

### <u>ANALYSIS</u>

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) and 455.065, Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 455.065, Stats.

In this proposed rule-making order the Psychology Examining Board revises s. Psy 4.02 (6), relating to limitation on continuing education credit for self-developed continuing education programs and uncompensated evaluation assistance services. The current rules do not limit the maximum number of continuing education hours for a specific continuing education program. The revised rule will limit any individual program to 20 hours.

The board believes that diversified continuing education is important for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the consumer by exposing psychologists to education to improve their knowledge necessary for competent practice. The board believes this can be accomplished by limiting the maximum number of continuing education credit hours granted for any specific program.

#### TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Psy 4.02 (4) (c) is repealed.

SECTION 2. Psy 4.02 (6) is amended to read:

Psy 4.02 (6) LIMITATION ON CREDIT. The board may grant no more than 20 hours of continuing education credit per biennium for self-developed continuing education programs, no more than 20 hours of credit for uncompensated evaluation assistance services, and no more

than 20 hours of credit for any combination of self-developed continuing education programs and uncompensated evaluation assistance services, and no more than 20 hours of credit within any specific continuing education program.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register pursuant to s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
