ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING, AMENDING AND REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board proposes an order to repeal NR 10.125(4)(a)2, amend NR 10.001(19) and 10.125(2)(b)1. and 2., and(4)(a)1., and repeal and recreate NR 10.01(1)(b), (f)2, (g)1.a.-k., (g)2., (g)3., (u)1 and (u)2. And creating NR 10.01(1)(v) relating to the 1997 migratory game bird season.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.085, 29.155, 29.174(3), and 227.11(2)(a), Stats. Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085, 29.155, 29.174(1) and (2), Stats.

The proposed rules establish the regulations for the 1997 migratory game bird season. The significant regulations are:

Ducks. The state is divided into two zones each with 60-day seasons. The season in the southern duck zone begins at noon October 4 and continues for 60 days, closing December 2. The north duck zone season begins at noon October 4 and continues through December 2. The daily bag limit in both zones is 6 ducks, including four mallards, of which only one may be a hen, and one canvasback for the entire 60 days in both zones. A special youth duck hunt on September 27 is established.

Canada Geese. The state is apportioned into 3 goose hunting zones: Horicon, Collins and Exterior. Other special goose management subzones within the Exterior Zone include Brown County, Burnett County, New Auburn, Rock Prairie and the Mississippi River. Season lengths are: Collins Zone - 68 days; Horicon Zone - 93 days; Exterior Zone - 93 days; and Mississippi River Subzone - 70 days. The Burnett County and New Auburn subzones are closed to Canada goose hunting.

Woodcock season dates, season length and bag limits are changed to comply with the federal framework.

Bismuth-tin and tungsten shot are legalized for migratory bird hunting.

SECTION 1. NR 10.001(19) is amended to read:

NR 10.001(19) "Nontoxic shot" means steel shot and copper, nickel, zinc chloride and zinc chromate plated steel shot with the plating not exceeding .0002 inches of 1% or less of shot by weight, or other shot approved by the U.S. fish and wildlife service for waterfowl hunting in 50 C.F.R. 20.21.

SECTION 3. NR 10.01(1)(v) is created to read:

NR 10.01(1)(v) Special youth duck hunt event. Persons 12 years of age or older but under 16 years of age who possess a certificate of accomplishment under s. 29.225, Stats. may hunt all species of wild duck on September 27. Approvals under s. 29.09, Stats., are not required pursuant to s. 29.155(1), Stats. Daily bag limits are those described under s. NR 10.01(1)(b) and all other waterfowl hunting regulations apply. Hunters shall be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older. One adult may not accompany more than 2 hunters.

SECTION 4. NR 10.125(2)(b)1.and 2.and (4)(a)1. are amended to read:

NR 10.125(2)(b)1. All applications for the Horicon and Collins zones and the early goose hunt subzone shall be postmarked no later than the deadline dates indicated on the forms or received by the department license section no later than 4:30 p.m. on that date to be considered for selection. The annual application deadlines may not be sooner than July 1.

2. Exterior zone and early goose hunt subzone permit applications may be obtained by mail or in person at department district regional offices and area offices service centers during normal office hours throughout the open season.

(4) (a) 1. The department may require each successful <u>exterior zone and early goose hunt</u> <u>subzone</u> applicant to submit a harvest report in a manner prescribed by the department within 48 hours of harvesting a goose.

SECTION 5. NR 10.125(4)(a)2. is repealed.
