## ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING, RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board adopts an order to repeal NR 20.20(1)(f), (6)(f), (9)(e), (11)(i), (18)(f), (29)(f), (37)(g), (47)(f), (50)(f), (56)(h) and (72)(f); to renumber NR 20.20(33)(a), (55)(b) and (64)(h)7.; to amend NR 20.15, 20.20(4)(c), (7)(c), (13)(a)1., (22)(a)1., (25)(a)1., (26)(d)2., (53)(a), (57)(e)2., (64)(c)1., (70)(b)1. and 2., (d)1. and (g)1., (73)(f)4., 21.04(1) and 23.05(5)(c); to repeal and recreate NR 20.20(73)(e)2.b. and (me); and to create NR 20.03(28m), 20.06(3m), 20.20(2)(dm), (4)(i)3., (9)(dm), (16)(h)3., (25)(c)2. and (em), (33)(a), (55)(b), (bs) and (bw), (64)(h)7., (65)(dm), (68)(d)3., (73)(e)2g. and 2m., 20.33(5) and 26.26 relating to fishing regulations for inland, outlying and boundary waters and fish refuges

#### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 23.09(2), 29.014(1), 29.191(5), 29.192(3) and (4), 29.041 and 227.11(2), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 23.09(2), 29.014(1), 29.191(5) and 29.192(3) and (4), Stats.

Section 1 designates additional reaches of tributaries to Lake Michigan as "Outlying trout and salmon waters" for the purposes of establishing where the Great Lakes Trout and Salmon Stamp is required;

Section 1h prohibits the possession of live bait on waters where only the use of artificial lures is authorized;

Section 2 authorizes an the early catch and release season for trout on trout streams with a restriction on the use of barbed hooks;

Sections 3 and 40 close most waters to shovelnose sturgeon fishing and reduce the daily bag limit for shovelnose sturgeon from 25 to 3 on those waters remaining open;

Section 4 establishes a daily bag limit of 10 for panfish on Lake Galilee, Ashland County;

Section 5 establishes an 18-inch minimum length limit and a daily bag limit of 1 for largemouth and smallmouth bass on Cable and Wiley lakes, Bayfield County;

Section 5m establishes a 20" to 28" protected slot length limit and a daily bag limit of 3, with only 1 longer than 28" allowed, for walleye, sauger and their hybrids on Diamond lake, Bayfield county;

Section 6 places Webb Lake, Burnett County in the southern bass zone;

Section 7 establishes a daily bag limit of 10 for panfish on Long, Herde and Dark Lakes, Chippewa County;

Section 7m allows trolling on all waters of Dane County;

Section 8 removes the minimum length limit for walleye on Beauregard Lake, Douglas County and establishes a daily bag limit of 5, but only 1 may be longer than 14 inches;

Section 9 allows trolling in all waters of Grant County;

Section 10 allows trolling in all waters of Iowa County;

Section 11 establishes catch and release only for largemouth and smallmouth bass on Twin Valley Lake, Iowa County for three years;

Section 14 establishes a daily bag limit of 10 for panfish on Cox Hollow Lake, Iowa County, and eliminates the daily bag limit for panfish on Twin Valley Lake, Iowa County;

Section 17 establishes a daily bag limit of 10 for panfish on Bearskull, Island and Spider Lakes, Iron County;

Sections 18 and 19 allow trolling on all waters of Lafayette County;

Section 20 allows trolling on all waters of Richland County;

Sections 21 and 22 establish a minimum length limit of 18 inches and a daily bag limit of 1 for largemouth and smallmouth bass on Murphy Flowage, Rusk County;

Section 23 establishes a minimum length limit of 26 inches and a daily bag limit of 2 for northern pike on Murphy Flowage, Rusk County;

Section 24 establishes a daily bag limit of 10 for panfish on Murphy Flowage, Rusk County;

Section 25 establishes a minimum length limit of 40 inches for muskellunge on Sissabagama Lake, Sawyer County;

Section 26 establishes catch and release only for largemouth and smallmouth bass on Big Lake, Vilas County;

Sections 27 and 28 establish a minimum length limit of 28 inches and a daily bag limit of 1 for walleye, sauger and hybrids on Kentuck Lake, Vilas County;

Sections 29 and 30 establish a daily bag limit of 10 for panfish on Lulu lake, Walworth County, and Eagle Spring Lake, Waukesha County;

Sections 31, 33 and 34 eliminate the continuous open fishing season for largemouth and smallmouth bass, northern pike and walleye, sauger and hybrids on Irogami (Fish), Pine and Big Twin Lakes, Waushara County;

Section 32 removes the minimum length limit for largemouth and smallmouth bass on Round Lake, Waushara County and establishes a daily bag limit of 3, but no fish from 14 through 18 inches may be kept and only 1 may be longer than 18 inches;

Section 35 establishes a 2-day sturgeon spearing season on Poygan, Winneconne and Butte des Morts lakes on February 12 and 13, 2000, with a 36 inch minimum length limit;

Section 36 establishes a 70 inch minimum length limit for lake sturgeon in even numbered years on the Lower Wisconsin River downstream from the Wisconsin Dells Dam;

Section 37 closes the hook and line lake sturgeon fishing season on Lake Michigan, Green Bay and their tributaries;

Section 38 changes the boundary for the northern bass zone from state highway 70 to state highway 77, Burnett, Sawyer and Washburn Counties;

Section 44 establishes total allowable harvest levels for lake sturgeon and establishes a procedure for closing the sturgeon spearing season on Lake Winnebago system waters when 80% of the total allowable harvest is reached;

Section 45 establishes a 14 inch minimum length limit for largemouth and smallmouth bass on the St. Louis River and connected waters and on the St. Croix River upstream from the dam at St. Croix Falls and establishes a catch and release only season from the Monday following Labor Day to March 1 on the St. Croix River upstream from the dam at St. Croix Falls;

Section 46 establishes a 70 inch minimum length limit for lake sturgeon in even numbered years on the all Wisconsin-Michigan boundary waters; and

Section 47 establishes a fish refuge for spawning panfish on a portion of Cox Hollow Lake, Iowa County, from the third Monday in May for 19 consecutive days.

### SECTION 1. NR 20.03(28m) is created to read:

NR 20.03(28m) "Outlying trout and salmon waters" means those waters designated as outlying trout and salmon waters pursuant to s. 29.191(4), Stats., Lake Michigan tributaries as defined in s. NR 20.03(18), and the Little river from its confluence with the Oconto river upstream to the highway 141 bridge.

#### SECTION 1h. NR 20.06(3m) is created to read:

NR 20.06(3m) Possess or control any live bait or any other baits, hooks or lures other than artificial lures while on the waters, banks or shores of waters where only the use of artificial lures is authorized in subch. III.

#### SECTION 2. NR 20.15 is amended to read:

NR 20.15 Early catch and release season for trout. Except where specifically restricted in s. NR. 20.20, there (1) There is an open season for trout in all trout streams, except as specified in sub. (2), from March 1 at 5:00 a.m. to the Friday immediately preceding the first Saturday in May at 6 6:00 p.m. during 1997, 1998 and 1999 but the daily bag limit and possession limit for trout is 0 and only artificial lures with barbless hooks may be used for any species of fish while fishing for any species of fish on trout streams during this period.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to the following streams:

(a) Lake Michigan tributaries, major Green Bay tributaries, all other tributary streams, rivers and ditches to Green Bay upstream to the first first dam or lake.

(b) Portions of tributaries to Lake Superior with a season opening date other than the first Saturday in May as specified in s. NR 20.20.

(c) White river and its tributaries upstream from Pike River road bridge including the South Fork, West Fork and East Fork White river, Bayfield county.

(d) Tomorrow river from old railroad bridge crossing north of Amherst upstream to First street in Nelsonville, Portage County.

(e) Tomorrow river from Clementson road upstream to Poncho creek, Portage county.

(f) White river (west branch), Waushara county.

Note: The early catch and release seasons during 1997, 1998 and 1999 do season does not apply to spring ponds, ponds or lakes

(25) IOWA COUNTY. (a) That portion of the Cox Hollow lake within 100 feet of the shoreline on the southern arm of the lake that is marked with buoys.
