**PSC 52.07 (MC-1194) Truck operations through Port Washington.** All common motor carriers, contract motor carriers, and private motor carriers are directed and authorized to operate trucks or tractor-trailer combinations weighing more than  $3\frac{1}{2}$  tons unloaded on highways 144 and 57 between their respective junctions with highway 141 in lieu of highway 141 between such junctions except when making pickup or delivery of freight in the city of Port Washington, the unincorporated village of Knellsville, and the village of Belgium. This section shall be suspended during the period that state trunk highway 57 between Saukville and the junction with state trunk highway 144 is under construction and traffic on said segment of highway 57 is detoured by the State Highway Commission over U. S. Highway 141.
