ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING AMENDED RULE

Section PSC 52.07, Wisconsin Administrative Code, as amended, was published in the September Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02 (1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes.

Now, therefore, pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin by sections 194.02, 194.14(1), 194.18(2), 194.36(2), 194.43, and 195.39, Statutes, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin hereby orders:

1. That section PSC 52.07 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, be and the same hereby is amended to read:

PSC 52.07 (MC-1194) Truck operations through Port Washington. All common motor carriers, contract motor carriers, and private motor carriers are directed and authorized to operate trucks or tractor-trailer combinations weighing more than 3½ tons unloaded on highways 144 and 57 between their respective junctions with highway 141 in lieu of highway 141 between such junctions except when making pickup or delivery of freight in the city of Port Washington, the unincorporated village of Knellsville, and the village of Belgium. This section shall be suspended during the period that state trunk highway 57 between Saukville and the junction with state trunk highway 144 is under construction and traffic on said segment of highway 57 is detoured by the State Highway Commission over U.S. Highway 141.

2. That section PSC 52.07 W.A.C., as herein amended and adopted, shall take effect December 1, 1956, as provided in section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.

THE COMMISSION FURTHER ORDERS:

That certified copies of section PSC 52.07, W.A.C., as above amended and adopted, be filed with the Revisor of Statutes and the Secretary of State as required by section 227.023, Wis. Stats.
