ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by section 93.07 (12), Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby amends rules as follows:

Section Ag 24.02 of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

Ag 24.02 Where found. The alfalfa weevil is known to be distributed as an insect pest in the following named states:

Arizona	Nevada	Pennsylvania
California	New Jersey	South Dakota
Colorado	New Mexico	Utah
Delaware	New York	Virginia
Idaho	North Carolina	Washington
Maryland	North Dakota	West Virginia
Montana	Oregon	Wyoming
Nebraska		

and such states are hereby declared to be infested.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on September 1, 1956.
