ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING AND RENUMBERING RULES

Section PSC 2.38(1)(b) was published in the June Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register, together with the proposal to renumber section PSC 2.38(1) to be PSC 2.38(1)(a). The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes.

Now, therefore, pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin by sections 196.36 and 227.08, Wis. Stats., the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin hereby orders:

1. That section PSC 2.38(1) be renumbered to be section PSC 2.38(1)(a).

2. That section PSC 2.38(1)(b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code be adopted to read:

PSC 2.38(1)(b) Where a party having the affirmative does not desire to file a brief but another desires to do so, the presiding commissioner or examiner shall specify the time and order for filing briefs. If the presiding commissioner or examiner makes no specific designation as to the time and order for filing briefs in cases where the party having the affirmative does not desire to file a brief, all other briefs shall be filed within 15 days after date of mailing of transcript. In any case not specifically covered by this rule, the time and order for filing briefs shall be fixed by the presiding commissioner or examiner.

3. That the renumbering and the section PSC 2.38(1)(b), as herein adopted, shall take effect September 1, 1956.

as provided in section 227.026(1), Statutes.

Further orders that certified copies of section PSC 2.38(1)(b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and the renumbering of section PSC 2.38(1) to be PSC 2.38(1)(a), as herein adopted, be filed with the Revisor of Statutes and the Secretary of State as required by section 227.023, Statutes.
