Stats.

H 37.04 Reporting required. The laboratory shall periodically report positive syphilis and gonorrhoea tests to the state board of health on blanks furnished by said board and as it directs.

H 37.05 Approval withdrawn. The board may withdraw approval of a laboratory upon the submission of evidence satisfactory to the board that the extent or character of the laboratory supervision is inadequate, that the quality of work performed by the laboratory is not up to acceptable standards, or that other requirements for approval are not complied with.
