Emergency modification as to  
overtime hours of 16 and 17  
year old boys in the canning  
industry.

Whereas the Industrial Commission of Wisconsin finds that by reason of the unusual rainfall and general shortage of labor in the canning industry during the 1956 canning season, an emergency has been created which affects the welfare of a large segment of farming and canning industry of the state; and unless immediate action is taken, serious loss may result to farmers and processors in the matter of handling of vegetables;

Wherefore, the Industrial Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends Order No. Ind. 73.05 and provisions relating thereto, to permit the employment of 16 and 17 year old boys in excess of maximum hours provided for in Ind. 73.01 for the period of 3 weeks in addition to the 10 weeks now provided for in said section.

That all other provisions of said orders shall remain unchanged.

That said amendment shall be effective only from date of publication of this amendment and for the balance of the 1956 canning season.
