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Proposed General Order to Prescribe)

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ORDER ADOPTING AMENDMENT, RENUMBERING,
CLARIFICATION, AND REPEAL OF RULES

Amended sections PSC 72.02(2) and PSC 72.03(2) were published in the January notice section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register, together with the proposals to repeal section PSC 72.06; to renumber sections PSC 72.02, PSC 72.03, and PSC 72.04; and to clarify section PSC 72.05. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes.

Now, therefore, pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin by section 195.34, Wisconsin Statutes, the Commission hereby orders:

1. That sections PSC 72.02(2) and PSC 72.03(2), Wisconsin Administrative Code, as presently numbered, be and the same hereby are amended to read:

PSC 72.02(2) In the event such accident involves personal injury, death, or property damage in excess of \$750, a complete report on said form shall be filed with the commission within 30 days after the close of the month in which said accident occurred.

PSC 72.03(2) Any nonfatal accident other than at a grade crossing which causes damage to railroad property of \$750 or more or disability to a railroad employee of more than 3 days or disability to a nonemployee of more than 1 day shall be reported to the commission by such means of communication as will insure delivery within 10 days.

2. That section PSC 72.06 be and the same hereby is repealed.

3. That sections PSC 72.02, PSC 72.03, and PSC 72.04 be and the same hereby are renumbered to be sections PSC 72.04, PSC 72.02, and PSC 72.03, respectively.

4. That, for the purpose of clarification;

(a) The title of section PSC 72.05 be and the same hereby is changed to read "Accident report form under section PSC 72.04," and

(b) That the words "(Instructions on Reverse Side)" appearing at the conclusion of section PSC 72.05 be and the same hereby are deleted.

FURTHER ORDERS that certified copies of amended sections PSC 72.02(2) and PSC 72.03(2) and the proposals to repeal, renumber and clarify Wisconsin Administrative Code sections, as herein adopted, be filed with the Revisor of Statutes and the Secretary of State, as required by section 227.023, Wisconsin Statutes.
