H 7.01 Facilities. Barber schools must provide rooms for practical work and for demonstration and lecture purposes.

H 7.02 Course of study. Sanitation and hygiene, selection and care of tools, shaving, hair cutting, facial massage, scalp treatment and anatomy must be taught in barber school by competent instructors.

H 7.03 Regulations. The sanitary regulations governing barber shops shall also include barber schools.

H 7.04 Student not entitled to time credit toward apprenticeship requirements. Any student regularly enrolled in a school or college teaching barbering and pursuing a course of study for credit as provided under section 158.09 (5), Wis. Stats., shall not be entitled to receive additional time credit toward meeting the requirements of apprenticeship for work hours spent in a barber shop during the period of his school enrollment.
