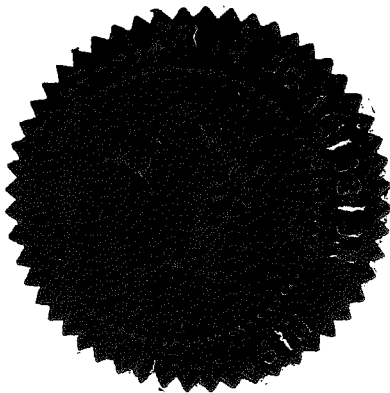

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085 and 29.174, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

Sections WCD 23.05 (1) and (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are amended to read:

WCD 23.05 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his possession or under his control from sunset to sunrise on any waters specified in this chapter, any spear or similar device that might be used to take, catch or kill fish, or at any time on any waters containing trout or in which trout have been planted.

(3) Rough fish may be taken by means of spears from sunrise to sunset only from April 1 to May 14 in the waters of Menominee River.

Section WCD 23.05 (4) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 23.05 (4) Cisco and whitefish may be taken by means of spears from October 15 to December 31 of each year in the waters of Smoky Lake. Such spearing may be done in either the daytime or at night and with the aid of artificial lights.

The rules and amendments contained herein shall take effect on September 1, 1957.
