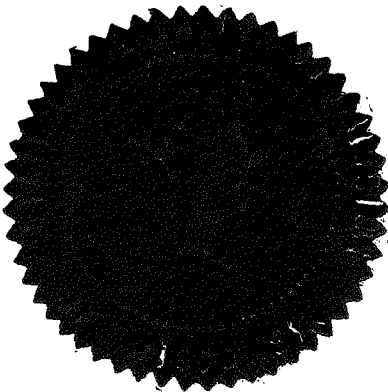

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION ADOPTING, AMENDING
AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by section 23.09, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

Sections WCD 26.01 (57) (a), (66) (a) and (68) (a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are repealed.

Section WCD 26.04 (13) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 26.04 (13) Dane County. (a) Castle Marsh. All of the marshland commonly known as "Castle Marsh" lying north and east of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad right-of-way in the following described area:

Township 8 North, Range 9 East

Section 36 - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; SE diagonal NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$;
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and all of the marshland outlet channel into Lake Mendota and that water area of Lake Mendota proper extending 100 feet in any direction from the mouth of said marshland outlet channel and lying south and west of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad right-of-way in the following described area:

Township 8 North, Range 9 East

Section 36 - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section WCD 26.07 (introductory paragraph) is amended to read:

WCD 26.07 (introductory paragraph) The following described areas are hereby created and established as fish refuges, and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, catch, capture, kill, or fish for fish in any manner from March 1 to June 30 each year, both dates inclusive, in, on or along the following described water areas.

Section WCD 26.07 (29) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 26.07 (29) Juneau County. (a) Meadow Valley Flowage. That part of the Meadow Valley Flowage lying in the following described area:

- Township 20 North, Range 2 East
- Section 1 - $W\frac{1}{2}$
- Sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 - Entire sections.
- Section 7 - $N\frac{1}{2}$
- Section 8 - $N\frac{1}{2}$
- Section 9 - $N\frac{1}{2}$
- Section 10 - $N\frac{1}{2}$
- Section 11 - All that part lying north of the Meadow Valley Flowage road and west of State Highway 173.

Section WCD 26.10 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section WCD 26.16 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 26.16 FISH REFUGES. The following described areas are hereby created and established as fish refuges, and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, catch, capture, kill, or fish for fish in any manner from March 1 to May 31 each year, both dates inclusive, in, on or along the following described water areas:

(14) Dodge County. (a) Beaver Creek. All that part of Beaver Creek beginning at the highway bridge at the inlet of Beaver Dam Lake and extending upstream to the county trunk highway "G" bridge, all in sections 8, 9 and 19, Township 12 North, Range 13 East.

Section WCD 26.19 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 26.19 FISH REFUGES. The following described areas are hereby created and established as fish refuges and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, capture, kill or fish for fish in any manner or at any time except during the open season for muskellunge in, on or along the following described water areas:

(57) Sawyer County. (a) Chippewa River. Beginning at the gate of the reservoir dam known as the Winter Dam in Government Lots 1 and 9 in Section 2, Township 39 North, Range 6 West, Sawyer County, Wisconsin and extending downstream 1,000 feet.

Section WCD 26.20 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 26.20 FISH REFUGES. The following described areas are hereby created and established as fish refuges and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, capture, kill, or fish for fish in any manner from April 15 to June 1 each year, both dates inclusive, in, on or along the following described water areas:

(57) Sawyer County. (a) Whitefish Creek. The entire length of Whitefish Creek from Whitefish Lake to Lac Court Oreilles, all lying in Sections 11 and 12, Township 39 North, Range 9 West.

The rules, amendments and repeals contained herein shall take effect September 1, 1957.
