ORDER ADOPTING AMENDED RULE

Section PSC 69.02(3), as smended, was published in the November 1957 Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes.

Now, therefore, pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin by sections 194.02, 194.18(9), and 194.36(9), Statutes, the Public Service Commission hereby orders:

1. That section PSC 69.02(3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code be and the same is hereby amended to read:

> PSC 69.02(3) Each common motor carrier who does not desire to participate in such tariff shall publish in its intrastate rate tariffs a rule showing that such commodities will not be handled in either single- and/or joint-line traffic on its line.

2. That section PSC 69.02(3) as herein amended shall take effect on February 1, 1958, as provided in section 227.026(1), Statutes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that certified copies of section PSC 69.02(3), Wisconsin Administrative Code, as herein emended and adopted, be filed with the Revisor of Statutes and the Secretary of State as required by section 227.023, Statutes.
