ORDER REPEALING RULES

According to section 227.01(5)(s), created by Chapter 426, Laws of 1957, an administrative code "rule" does not include or mean action which "prescribes or relates to a uniform system of accounts for persons, including municipalities, regulated by the Public Service Commission."

While the Commission will continue to require that "Every public utility shall keep and render to the Commission in the manner and form prescribed...uniform accounts of all business transacted," as stated in section 196.06, Statutes, and in the above entitled dockets, such procedure need not now be stated as part of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

In conformity with the new statute, section 227.01(5)(s), Chapter PSC 160 should be repealed.

Order

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS:

1. That Chapter PSC 160, Wisconsin Administrative Code, be and it hereby is repealed.
2. That it is not herein intended in any way to repeal or affect any order heretofore issued by the Commission prescribing a uniform system of accounts for anyone subject to its jurisdiction. This order is designed simply to accomplish the administrative act of removing from the Wisconsin

Administrative Code material which does not now fall within the definition of a rule (section 227.01(5)(s), Statutes).

3. That certified copies of this order be sent to the Revisor of Statutes and the Secretary of State, as required by section 227.023, Statutes.
