Dear Mr. Burke:

As provided in Section 227.023, Wisconsin Statutes, I hereby submit a certification to the effect that Section H 46.60 to H 46.66, inclusive, Admission of Patients to State Tuberculosis Camp, of the Wisconsin Administrative Code was repealed by the Wisconsin State Board of Health on August 1, 1958. This certification is submitted for publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register. It is hoped that the certification can be published in the August issue of the Register so the effective date of the repeal may be September 1, 1958.

Pursuant to Section 227.02 (1) (b), Wisconsin Statutes, the State Board of Health was not required to provide notice or hold a public hearing for reason that this repeal is designed solely to eliminate that part of the existing code which is no longer applicable due to statutory changes which were made by the 1957 legislature.

Copies of this certification are also being submitted to the Governor as required by Section 14.225 and to the Secretary of State as required by Section 227.023, Wisconsin Statutes.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

I, Carl N. Neupert, M.D., Executive Secretary of the Wisconsin State Board of Health and custodian of the official records of said Board, do hereby certify that Section H 46.60 to H 46.66, inclusive, Admission of Patients to State Tuberculosis Camp, of the Wisconsin Administrative Code was repealed by this Board, without benefit of notice and public hearing as provided in Section 227.02 (1) (b), on August 1, 1958, pursuant to authority vested in said Board by Section 140.05 (3), Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 50.04, Wisconsin Statutes, providing for the establishment and operation of the State Tuberculosis Camp, as well as for the prescribing of regulations for admission thereto, was repealed by Chapter 526, Section 5, Laws of 1957.

This repeal shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wisconsin Statutes, subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.225, Wisconsin Statutes.
