ORDER ADOPTING AMENDED RULES

Sections PSC 2.60 (4), PSC 2.61, PSC 2.63, and PSC 2.80 (7)(b), as amended, were published in the June Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02 (1)(e), Wis. Stats.

Now, therefore, pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin by sections 196.405 and 227.08, Wis. Stats., the Commission orders:

1. That the following sections of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, as amended, be and the same hereby are adopted to read:

PSC 2.60 (4) Five copies of all applications for rehearing or objections thereto shall be filed and shall include a certification that copies have been served as required by section PSC 2.61. Such certificate shall state the names of the persons served, together with the date and manner of service.

PSC 2.61 Service of rehearing applications and objections. Applications for rehearing shall be served on all parties to the proceeding. Objections to an application for rehearing shall be served on all parties and filed with the commission within 7 days after the date of service of such application. Such applications for rehearing and objections thereto shall be accompanied by a certificate showing the names of the persons upon whom service was made and the date and manner of service.

PSC 2.63 Petitions for reopening. Parties may petition the commission to reopen a proceeding for the purpose of rescinding, amending, or altering

an order or determination (section 196.39, Wis. Stats.). Such petition shall state the ground upon which it is based and the relief sought. It shall be served in the same manner as applications for rehearing. Five copies shall be filed with the commission. Objections to a petition may be filed and served in the same manner as objections to an application for rehearing. Petitions for reopening and objections thereto shall be accompanied by a certificate showing the names of the persons upon whom service was made and the date and manner of service.

PSC 2.80 (7)(b) The petition filed with the commission shall include a certification that a copy has been served as provided in (a). Such certificate shall state the name of the person served, together with the date and manner of serving.

2. That the above amended rules shall take effect on September 1, 1958, as provided for in section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.

FURTHER ORDERED That certified copies of sections PSC 2.60 (4), PSC 2.61, PSC 2.63, and PSC 2.80 (7)(b), Wisconsin Administrative Code, as herein amended and adopted, be filed with the Revisor of Statutes and the Secretary of State as required by section 227.023, Wis. Stats.
