MOFOR VEHICLE DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN TW THE MATTER OF DEFARTMENTAL RULES: ADOPTING CHAPT. MVD-13 MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS. \*

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commissioner of Motor Vehicle Department in Section 110.06 Wis, Stats., and after due notice and public hearing as provided under Chapt. 227 Wis. Stats., the Commissioner hereby adopts the following rules:

13.01 The "\*\* facilities to display automobiles \*\*" as required under 341.50 (1) shall be an area set aside for the sole purpose of displaying vehicles offered for sale of not less than 12 feet by 20 feet in area.

13.02 That the minimum of books and records required to be kept by licensed Visconsin dealers under 341.50 (1) and other relevant Statutes consists as follows: (1) Titles or other evidence of ownership of each vehicle owned and offered for sale; (2) All original or copies of vehicle purchase orders, invoices and other records of sale for a period of one year from the date of sale.
