ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AMENDING AND ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07 (1), 98.15 and 100.20 (2), Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

SECTION 1. The title of chapter Ag 102 of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read: "DAIRY PLANTS, FALSE RECORDS."

SECTION 2. Section Ag 102.01 of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

Ag 102.01 <u>Statements to patrons</u>. No dairy plant operator shall furnish to patrons, from whom he receives milk or cream, any statement or accounting which contains false or misleading figures or a false or misleading computation or arrangement of figures.

SECTION 3. Section Ag 102.02 of the Wisconsin administrative code is adopted to read:

Ag 102.02 Record keeping. (1) Every dairy plant operator

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shall keep true and accurate records for each payroll period of his receipts and sales or other disposition of all milk, dairy products and dairy by-products which will permit an accurate and full accounting of receipts, utilization and disposition of such milk, dairy products and dairy by-products, and products manufactured therefrom. Such records shall be retained for a period of 3 years and shall include:

(a) Pounds of milk, dairy products or dairy by-products received.

(b) Pounds of butterfat contained in all milk, deiry products or dairy by-products received.

(c) Pounds of milk, dairy products or dairy by-products manufactured, sold or otherwise disposed of.

(d) The per cent of fat and moisture content for each such product or by-product when determined by or furnished to the dairy plant.

(2) A determination by the department, after an audit of such records, that the sales or other disposition of milk, dairy products or dairy by-products on the basis of the butterfat content thereof exceed the quantity of butterfat received is evidence that such records are false and inaccurate.

(3) In addition to the penalties provided for violation of this chapter, whenever such records are determined to be false and inaccurate the department may conduct a complete investigation and require the filing of detailed reports of purchases, sales and utilization of milk, dairy products and dairy byproducts for each payment period on forms prescribed by the de-

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partment. No dairy plant operator who is given notice to file reports pursuant to this subsection shall file any false report or fail to file reports at the times required in such notice.
