ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION CONSISSION OF VISCONSIS ADOPTING SULES

Fursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 30.50 to 30.80, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Conservation Commission of Misconsin hereby adopts rules as follows:

WAD 5.01 APPLICATION FOR HOAT CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER. (1) The application for a boat certificate of number shall include the following:

(a) Name and address of boat owner.

(b) Bost type - notorboat, sailboat, other. at its way on block the

(c) Boat description - make, length, year, serial number (if any).

(d) Type of use - pleasure, livery, dealer, manufacturer, connercial, the other.

(e) Type of propulsion - inboard, outboard, other.

(f) Type of fuel - gascline, diesel, other.

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(g) Hull material - wood, aluminum, steel, plastic, other.

(b) mooring address - city, village, township, county.

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WCD 5.02 APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER. An application for a transfer certificate of number in addition to furnishing the information required by ACD 5.01 shall include a statement by the applicant listing the name end address of the previous owner, his certificate number, and the date on which the boat was acquired by the applicant. The applicant shall also sign the statement.

WGD 5.63 APPLICATION FUR HUPLICHTE. An applicant for a duplicate certificate of number in addition to furnishing the information required by WCD 5.01 shall complete and sign a statement that the original certificate has been either destroyed, or lost and that the spalication being and is for a duplicate.

SCD 5.04 CERTIFICATE OF RUMBER. (1) The boat certificate of number issued in accordance with s. 30.52. Wis. Stats., shall include the following:

(2) The certificate of number shall be available at all times for inspection on the boat when in use. The federal boating act does not authorize any execution from this regularment.

WCD 5.05 NURDERLAN PATTERN TO BE USED. The bost certificate of number issued surguant to s. 30.52. As. Stats., shall be in accordance with the pattorn described as follows:

(1) The nuclear shall be divided into parts. The first part of the number shall be an abbreviation in capital letters of the state of Misconsin. This abbreviation shall be MS. The remainder of the number shall consist of not more nor less than four arabic numerals and two capital letters.

WCD 5.09 UNIFORM ALLS TO RAVIDATION. United States Coast Guard Publication CO-193, revised June, 1959, entitled "Alds to Marine Mevigation of the United States", is hereby adopted and all aids to mavigation placed in any of the waters of the state under the authority of any local regulation or by state authority shall conform thereto with the exception that swimming areas shall be marked with alternate yellow and green banded buoys in sufficient numbers to clearly outline the outside limits of the swimming area. Copies of United States Coast Guard Publication CO-193, revised June, 1939, entitled "Aids to Marine Mavigation" are on file with the Wisconsin Conservation Department, the Secretary of State, and the Newisor of Statutes. Copies of the publication are available on request from the Wisconsin Conservation Department, Madison, Wisconsin, and the U. S. Coast Guard, Marine Inspection Office, Milsaukee, Misconsin.

WCD 5.10 CANBURGTOR FLANS ASRASTORS. Every sotortost equipped with an inboard motor using gasoline as a fuel shall have the carburetors of every such motor fitted with an efficient device for arresting backfire of a type approved by the U. S. Cosst Guard.

WeD 5.11 FIRS EXTINGUISHERS. Fire extinguishers required by s. 30.62 (4), wis. State., shall comply with the following minimum specifications:

- Type Capable of promptly and effectively extinguishing burning gasoline (carbon tetrachloride not approved).
- Size A. Foam (minimum gallons 1) or carbon dioxide (minimum pounds 4) or pry chemical (minimum pounds 2).

8. Foam (minimum gallons 25) or carbon dioxide (minisua counds 15) or dry chemical (minimum pounds 10).

The fire extinguishers required on each class of actorbost shall be as follows:

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Class of Hotorboat	Size and Number of Extinguishers Required
Class A (less than 16 feet)	l size A
Class 1 (16 feet to 26 feet)	l size A
Class 2 (25 feet to 40 feet)	2 size A or 1 size B
Class 3 (40 feet or over)	3 size A or 1 size B and 1 size A

When the angine compartment of the motorboat is equipped with a fixed (bullt-in) extinguishing system of an approved coast guard type, the number of Size A extinguishers required may be reduced by one.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on April 1, 1960.
