

- 11 WCD 45.01 STATE FEOFESTY. (1) Except when the context provides otherwise, the provisions of this chapter shall apply to all lands, structures and property owned, leased or administered by the state of Wisconsin and under the management, supervision and control of the state conservation commission of Winconsin.

(2) It shall be unlawful for any person to destroy, solest or deface any natural growth or natural or archeologic feature. or any state property: to enter in any way any building, installation or area that may be looked or closed to public use, or contrary to posted notice. axcept in state parks, state recreation areas or as otherwise costed, the picking or harvesting of edible fruits or muts is permitted.

WCD 45.02 /80/18TY OF OTHERS. It shall be unlawful for any person to destroy, solest or recove the property of others. It shall be unlawful for any person other than a permittee or licensee to scavenge golf balls on any golf course.

- or leave any rotuse, sewage or other waste material on the ground, or in any building or installation, or into the water or upon the ice of any lake or stream or other body of water, or to dispose of any such refuse or waste material in any manner except by burning or by placing in receptables or other authorized locations provided for such purposes. Charcoal residue must be left in a grate or fireplace until cool, or placed in receptables provided for such purposes.
- pets, except at authorized locations, in any state park, state recreation area, fish hatchery and improved campaite in any state forest or at any similar public use area on other lands and property under the management, supervision and control of the state conservation commission of Wisconsin.
- (2) It shall be unlawful, except at authorized locations, to wash clothing in any state park, state recreation area, lish hatchery and improved campaite or similar public use area in any state forest.
- wcD 45.05 PETS. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to suffer his pet to enter any public building or be upon any beach or lakeshore or in any take, stream or other body of water, in any state park, state recreation area, improved campaits in any state forest. fish hatchery or similar public use area. There pets are permitted in the in the afore-mentioned areas, dogs shall be kept on a leash not more than eight feet long and all other pets shall be effectively restrained or under the owner's control at all times. No person shall suffer his pet to deprive or disrupt the enjoyment or use of any area by others.
- (2) Nothing in this section shall prohibit or restrict the use of dogs for hunting purposes in any area which is open to hunting.
- build or maintain any fire or to burn any refuse except at designated fireplaces in any state park, state recreation area, improved campaite in any state forest, fish hatchery or the State Experimental Game and Fur Farm. The afore-mentioned is also unlawful when fireplaces are revided at other campaites, picnic grounds and other designated similar public use areas on state forest lands or other lands under the management, supervision and control of the state conservation commission of Wisconsin.
- (2) It shall be unlawful for any person to leave any fire unattended, or to throw away any matches, digarettes, digare, or pipe ashes without first extinguishing them, or to start any fire contrary to posted notice on any lands or property under the management, supervision and control of the state conservation commission of Misconsin.

person to peddle or solicit business of any nature whatever, or to distribute handbills or other advertising matter, to post unauthorized signs on any lands, structures, or property under the management, supervision and control of the state conservation commission of Wisconsin, or to use such lands, structures or property as a base of commercial operations for soliciting or conducting business, paddling or providing services within or outside of such lands, structures or property unless first authorized in writing by the state conservation commission of visconsin or its duly authorized agents.

WCD 45.08 VEHICULAR TRAFFIC. (1) No person shall operate any vehicle at a speed in excess of 25 miles per hour unless different limits are indicated by official traffic eigns in any state park, state reoreation area, Laproved campaits in any state forest, or other public use areas on state forest lands or other lands under the management, supervision and control of the state conservation commission of Wisconsin.

- (2) No unauthorized person shall operate any vehicle upon any service road or other road closed to public travel.
- (3) No person shall operate any vehicle the gross weight of which is in excess of the costed weight limit.

WGD 45.09 BOATS. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motorboat of any kind in any manner on the following specified water:

- (a) Lakes of the Dalles in Interstate Park, section 31, T34%, R18%, and section 36, T34%, R19%, town of St. Croix Falls, Polk County, Wisconsin.
- (b) Interfalls Lake in Pattison state park, sections 21, 22, 27 and 28, T47K, Rl4W, town of Superior, Douglas County, Misconsin.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any sound truck, loud-speaker, motor, motorboat, motor vehicle or other mechanical device that produces undue or unnecessary noises without first obtaining a written permit from the state conservation commission of Wisconsin or its duly authorized agent.

MCD 45.12 PARKING. (1) No person shall park, stop or leave standing, whether attended or unattended, any vehicle or watercraft:

- (a) In any manner as to block, obstruct or limit the use of any road, trail, waterway or winter sport facility, or
- (b) Outside of any area provided for such purposes when it is
- ... o (o) Contrary to posted-mettos, he allegad the medical appropriation of the contrary approximation.
- (2) No person shall leave, abandon or deposit any boat, skiff or other watercraft on any conservation area, wildlife area, or public hunting or fishing ground after 10 days following the close of the migratory waterfowl season or contrary to posted notice.

WCD 45.1) CAMPING. (1) It shall be unlawful to camp in any state park, state recreation area or improved campaite in any state forest

without a camping permit and payment of the required fees. No person shall camp on any state forest lands without a permit, whether or not the payment of fees is required; except a permit to camp is not required by any person when:

- (a) Travelling by watercraft upon the Brule River in the Brule River State Forest or the Flambeau River in the Flambeau River State Forest when not camped at an improved campaite, or
- (b) Travelling by watercraft upon cance routes and camping at posted overnight cance campaites in the Northern Highland State Forest, American Legica State Forest or Black Biver State Forest.
- (2) In any area where a permit and payment of fees is required, no person shall camp and no camping unit or camping equipment shall remain for a period greater than 21 days in any consecutive four-week period from June 1 to Labor Day. There is no sessonal limit on the total camping days in any state park, state recreation area, state forest or other area under the management, supervision, and control of the state conservation commission of Wisconsin.
- ()) So person shall camp on any lands under the management, supervision or control of the state conservation commission of Visconsin contrary to posted notice. No person shall set up or take down a camping unit during the hours when such acts are prohibited by posted notice.
- YOU 45.14 FindANNS. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his possession or under his control any firearm or sirgun unless the same is undersed and enclosed in a carrying case, or any bow unless the same is unstrung or enclosed in a carrying case, in any state park, fish hatchery, isproved campaite in any state forest, and other similar public use areas in state forests and state recreation areas, or within posted areas on state forest and other lands under the management, supervision, and control of the state conservation commission of Wisconsin.
- (2) No person shall take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, pursue, or otherwise disturb any wild animals or birds in any state perk, fish hatchery, improved campsite in any state forest or within posted areas on state forest lands and other lands under the management, supervision, and control of the state conservation commission of Wisconsin.
- ()) Nothing in this section shall promibit the use of the aforementioned weapons on designated target ranges within the areas listed in sub. (1).

MCD 45.15 PERSONAL COMMUCT. It shall be unlawful for any person to be intoxicated or to engage in any violent, abusive, loud, boisterous, vulgar, lewd, wanton, obscene or otherwise disorderly conduct tending to create a breach of the peace or to disturb or annoy others.

NCD 45.16 FEES AND CHARGES. It shall be unlawful for any person to use any facility, land or area for which a fee or charge has been established by the state conservation commission of Wisconsin without payment of such fee or charge.

WGD 45.17 EXCEPTIONS. Nothing in this chapter shall prohibit or hinder the state conservation commission of Wisconsin, its supervisors, managers, foresters, wardens, rangers, or other duly authorized agents, or any peace officers from performing their official duties.

The amendments contained herein shall take effect on May 1, 1760.
