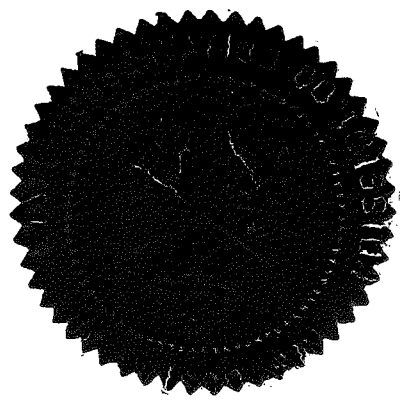

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN REPEALING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by Sections 23.09 and 29.17h, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby repeals and creates rules as follows:

Section WCD 26.01 (25) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section WCD 20.04 (h) (d) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 20.04 (h) (d). It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch or kill fish or fish for fish in, on or along any waters situated in Governor Dodge State Park in sections 2, 7, 10, 11, township 6 north, range 3 east, Iowa County, except under the following conditions:

1. Fishing in such waters is authorized only under permit, which may be secured at the checking station indicated by posted sign in the immediate area.
2. Fishing in such waters shall be done only with hook and line or rod and reel.
3. All permits are valid only for the date issued and shall be turned in at the checking station at the termination of each day's fishing activities by the fisherman.
4. Fishing is prohibited from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. of the following day.
5. All fish taken pursuant to this section shall be exhibited to the Conservation Commission or its agents at the checking station in a whole and uncleaned condition for examination and recording. When checking station personnel are not on duty, each permittee shall complete a creel census form provided and deposit the form at the checking station.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on June 1, 1960.
