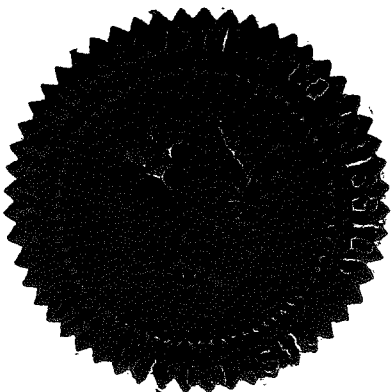

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING, AMENDING OR
REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085 and 29.174, Wis. stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts, amends and repeals rules as follows:

Section WCD 20.03 (1)(f) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Section WCD 20.03

(1)(f) Trout (any variety except muskellunge, splake and lake trout). Bag limit means total of all.

In all waters May 1 to September 7 10 6

There shall be an open season on muskellunge trout in Green Lake in Green Lake County only. May 1 to September 7 10 6

September 8 to February 15 10 6

There shall be a special open season for trout in the following waters:

Lake Superior (See also WCD 20.02 (1)(g))

Ashland county --
Red river from its mouth upstream to Copper Falls;
Potato river from its mouth upstream to Gurney Falls;
White river from its mouth upstream to White river dam;

Bayfield county --
Cranberry river from its mouth upstream to the Lonsene road (T304, S74, Sec. 30);

Fish river and Fish creek from its mouth upstream to the junction of Pine creek (T47N, R6W, Sec. 13);
 Flag river from its mouth upstream to the junction with the Little Flag river (T47N, R6W, Sec. 2);
 Iron river from its mouth upstream to Orienta dam;
 Sioux river from its mouth upstream to "Big Rock Falls" (T47N, R6W, Sec. 18);
 Siskiwitt river from its mouth upstream to the second bridge (T51N, R6W, Sec. 35);
