Administrative Code Rules Pertaining to Transportation of Used Household Goods and Business Equipment } NC-1653

ORDER REPEALING RULES
AND ADOPTING AMENDED RULE

Notice of proposed repeal of sections PSC 24.01, PSC 24.02, and PSC 24.07 and amendment of section PSC 16.52 (1) was published in the June 1960 Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02 (1)(e), Statutes.

ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by Chapter 194, Wis. Stats., the Commission orders that sections PSC 24.01, PSC 24.02, and PSC 24.07 be and the same hereby are repealed and that section PSC 16.52 be and the same hereby is amended to read as it appears in the following form to be filed with the Secretary of State and the Revisor of Statutes, as required by sections 227.023 and 227.024, Wis. Stats:

ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
REPEALING RULES AND ADOPTING AMENDED RULE

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by Chapter 194, Wis. Stats., the Public Service Commission hereby repeals and amends rules as follows:

Section PSC 16.52 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

PSC 16.52 (1) The carrier shall issue a bill of lading in triplicate for each and every shipment handled, one copy to be furnished to the shipper, one copy to be carried on the truck during transit, and one copy to be retained in the carrier's records. All bills of lading shall be serially numbered with all duplicates bearing the same serial number as the original. The carrier's copies of such bills of lading, whether used or spoiled, shall be kept and preserved by the carrier and be open to inspection by any authorized representative of the commission. Such bills of lading shall show the carrier's name; the date of movement; the name and address of the shipper; the name and address of the consignee; the points of origin and destination; the rate and charge for transportation; the value per pound of the shipment as declared by the shipper; the shipper's signature; the carrier's signature; the rate and charge for each and every service rendered for which the carrier has charges published and filed for accessorial services; and the gross, tare, and net weight in connection with shipments moved by weight. The scale ticket showing gross, tare, and net weights shall be attached to the carrier's copy of the bill of lading and retained as a record.

Sections PSC 24.01, PSC 24.02, and PSC 24.07 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE are repealed.

The repeal and amendment of rules as contained herein shall take effect on September 1, 1960, as provided in section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
