ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by section 93.09, Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby emends rules as follows:

Section Ag 84.04 (1) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

Ag 84.04 <u>Minimum holding period</u>. (1) Cheese that qualifies for any of the grades in section Ag 84.03 shall after date of manufacture be held by the producer for a period of at least six weeks.

The amendment of rules contained herein shall take effect on December 1, 1960.
