## ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Sections 140.05 (3) and 143.15 (5), Wis. Stats., the State Board of Health hereby adopts Subsection H 38.01 (2) (h) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relative to laboratory examinations of milk for residual antibiotics requiring certification to be acceptable as follows:

## (h) Residual antibiotics

The rule contained herein shall take effect on December 1, 1960, as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats., subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.225, Wis. Stats.
