

(j) All species of fish of lawful size may be taken from the outlying waters including Chequamegos bay by trailing from a motor drives or sailboat during the open season therefor. It shall be unlawful to spear any species or variety of fish in the outlying and reserve waters at any time, except that carp may be speared from suarise to sunset in all outlying waters and may be taken with the use of spear guns by the method commonly known as skin diving by divers under the water in Lake Michigan. Lake troot and northern pike may be speared through the ice in Lake Superior.

Section WCD 20.03 (1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and respected to read:

WCD 20.03 Season Tables: Open and Closed Seasons, Size and Bag Limits and Measurements. (1) The open seasons specified in the following table apply to fishing in open waters and fishing through the ice, except that the conservation director shall close the season for fishing through the ice in any inlead waters when he finds after scientific investigation and study that continued finding through the ice in such waters would result in a depletion of the supply of game fish therein and that such closed season is necessary to conserve the fish supply and insure the citizens of this state continued opportunities for good fishing therein and such closed seasons shall be put into effect by posting a notice thereof on or in the vicinity of the shore of the waters affected, such posting being deemed by the commission to be the most frasible way of potitying the public that such closed season is in effect and such closed seasons shall remain in full force and effect so long as such waters are covered with ice and so long as such posting is continued. For open sessons in specified waters see section WCD 20.04. The possession limit for each species of fish shall be double the daily bag limit specified in this chapter. The measurement of all fish taken shall be in a straight line from the tip of the anout to the utmost end of the tail fin fully extended.

No person shall have in his possession or under his control any spear or similar device in any building, tent, shanty or similar enclosure on the waters of Lake Butte des Morts and Winneconne in Winnebago county; Lake Poygan in Waushera and Winnebago counties; Lake Winnebago in Calumet, Fond du Lac, and Winnebago counties; Little Lake Butte des Morts in Outagamie and Winnebago counties, and all connecting waters including the Wolf river from the dam at Shawano downstream to Lake Poygan and the Fox river from Milepost No. 63, commonly known as Johnson creek in Green Lake county downstream to Lake Butte des Morts, except during the open season for spearing sturgeon when such open season is in effect on a specified water named above.

All speared sturgeon shell be tagged pursuant to Sec. 29.148 of the Wis. Stats.

(t) Paddle-fish or spoonbill catfish None

Section WCD 20.03 (4) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 20.03 (4) In those waters for which a permit for treatment with toxicant has been issued the conservation director may direct that all species of fish of any size may be taken by any legal means with no bag or possession limit from the date of issuance of said permit until the commencement of treatment and such open season shall be put into effect by posting a notice thereof on or in the vicinity of the waters affected and by publication in one or more newspapers having wide circulation in the area affected.

Section WCD 20.04 (1) (d) and (e) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are amended to read:

WCD 20.06 (1) (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to take, capture, or kill figh or figh for figh of any variety at any time in the inland waters of this state from a motor-driven bost when the motor is running or from any boat in tow of a motordriven boat when the motor is running or from any sailboat when in motion; or by means of shutting or drawing off water for that purpose.
