



ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE  
ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07 (1) and 93.09, Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby adopts rules as follows:

Sections Ag 81.01 (4) and Ag 81.15 of the Wisconsin administrative code are adopted to read:

Ag 81.01 (4) "Barrel cheese" is cheese without rind development which is cured in rigid impervious containers in which the curd is placed after manufacture.

Ag 81.15 Barrel cheese. In the case of barrel cheese the aforementioned grades are modified to the extent that the cheese may have numerous small openings resembling sweet holes.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on July 1, 1961.
