Pursuant to authority vested in the Industrial Commission of Wisconsin by Section 101.01-101.29 Wisconsin Statutes, and pursuant to Chapter 227, the Industrial Commission on June 1, 1961 voted to adopt the following rule relative to workmen's compensation.

Ind 80.30 AVERAGE WEEKLY EARNINGS FOR MEMBERS OF VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES OR FIRE DEPARTMENTS. The maximum average weekly earnings under the provisions of section 102.11, Wisconsin Statutes, which are in effect on the date of injury shall be used in computing the amount of compensation payable to an employe as defined by subsection 102.07 (7), except as specific showing may be made in an individual case that such wage is not proper.

The new order shall become effective on the first day of the month following its publication in the administrative code as provided in Section 227.
