STATE OF WISCONSIN Wisconsin Retirement Fund

Pursuant to authority vested in the Board of Trustees of the Wisconsin Retirement Fund by Section 66.912 (1) (t), Wis. Stats., the Board of Trustees amends and repeals the following rules to read:

Rule Ret 8.01 (1) is amended to read:

Ret 8.01 Variable segregation of future normal contributions. (1) Any participating employe may provide for a variable annuity through a segregation of <u>one-half</u> of the credits accumulated <u>in</u> <u>each quarter calendar year</u> from future normal and matching municipality contributions by filing with the fund a written notice of election on form 50.

Rules Ret 8.01 (2) and (3) are repealed.

The effective date shall be January 1, 1962, (but any participating employe may file an election pursuant hereto at any time prior thereto.)
