Notice of proposal to create section PSC 2.611 was published in the June 1961 Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02(1)(e), Statutes.

Order

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by 227.10(1), Wis. Stats., the Commission orders that section PSC 2.611, Wisconsin Administrative Code, be and the same hereby is created to read as follows:

PSC 2.611 Evidence upon rehearing. In a rehearing upon an order entered without hearing, the presiding officer may receive such evidence as he deems will be of assistance to the Commission in making a proper determination in the proceeding, and which otherwise complies with the provisions of section 227.10(1), Wis. Stats.

The rule as herein created shall take effect on
September 1, 1961, as provided in section 227.026(1), Wis.
Stats.
