**ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH
REPEALING RULES**

The State Board of Health hereby repeals rules as follows:

**Chapter M 81 (Collection of Carcasses and Construction
and Operation of Rendering Plants)**

Chapter M 82 (Slaughterhouses)

of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE are repealed.

The repeal of rules contained herein took effect on July 1,
1961.

NOTE: By chapter 191, Laws of 1961, jurisdiction
over rendering plants and slaughterhouses was trans-
ferred to the Department of Agriculture.

All powers and duties of the State Board of Health
with respect to rendering plants and slaughterhouses
therefore terminated on the effective date of said
chapter, July 1, 1961, and the rules repealed were
ineffective as of that date.
