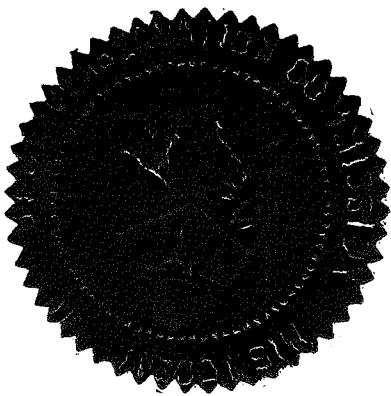

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.065 and 29.174, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts, amends and repeals rules as follows:

Section WCD 22.03 (16) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 22.03 (16) Crayfish. There shall be an open season for the taking of crayfish from the Saturday nearest May 1 to March 1, both dates inclusive, with no bag limit and no size limit.

Section WCD 22.06 (4) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 22.06 (4) SET OR BANK POLES (set Hooks). Set or bank poles (set hooks) may be used for the taking, catching, killing or fishing for catfish 13 inches or over in length, haddock sturgeon 25 inches or over in length, bullheads and rough fish only, during the period of time extending from the Saturday nearest May 1 to the next succeeding October 31; size limits shall conform to the provisions of section WCD 22.09. In such fishing it shall be unlawful to use any game fish or frog, either dead or alive as bait.



and not more than 72 inches in circumference, over-all dimensions and with one end thereof closed with webbing of a mesh not less than one and one-fourth inches per or square measure may be used for the taking of rough fish, bullheads 9 inches or over and catfish 13 inches or over during the period of time extending from the Saturday nearest May 1 to the next succeeding October 31 and shall be equipped with a metal tag as prescribed in section 89.34.3, vis. Stats. Such webbing shall be attached in such manner that the length, depth or width of such mesh is not decreased. Licenses for such basket traps (slat nets) shall be obtained pursuant to section 89.34.3, vis. Stats. All such nets mentioned above must be lifted at least once in every 48-hour period, unless a longer period is granted by the Wisconsin Conservation Commission or its agents.

(10) It shall be lawful for any person licensed pursuant to section 89.34.3 (3), vis. Stats., to use a trammel net not more than 300 feet in length and with a mesh of any size for the taking of fish as set forth in section WCD 22.09. Such trammel nets may be used throughout the year in that part of the Mississippi river between the states of Wisconsin and Iowa under the jurisdiction of the state of Wisconsin which lies within the navigation channel as established by the United States War Department in the Twelve Mile (Cassville) stretch, State Line through and Hurricane Route in Grant county. Such trammel nets may be used in a drifting manner only. It shall be unlawful for any person to use or operate any trammel net in any manner except as provided in this section.

Section WCD 22.12 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1962.
